

One ski pass – twice the fun

**Kühtai-Hochoetz**

Discover two snowsure ski resorts with a single ski pass. Explore 90 kilometres of slopes, 27 cable cars and lifts and an ample selection of restaurants across the Kühtai-Hochoetz ski region. A free shuttle bus runs between the two resorts every half hour. Hop on right by the slopes, then throw yourself at a whole new set of runs in the other resort just 15 minutes later.

Ski Resort Kühtai

Kühtai has it all – with guaranteed snow from early December until late April, wintersports enthusiasts can make the most of their holidays at Austria’s highest-altitude ski resort, located near Innsbruck at 2,020 metres above sea level. Ski right to your hotel doorstep or car park. Ski runs at every difficulty rating cater to a wide range of preferences. Families love the wide slopes. Freeskiers and snowboarders have their home base at the KPark Kühtai with its freestyle arena and Snowcross track, and kids and Funpark beginners can expect plenty of action at the KidsPark. Alternatively, there’s tobogganing, night-time skiing, cross-country skiing, snowshoe hiking – you name it.

Hochoetz ski resort

With more than 70 sunny days every winter, you’ll want to make your holiday in Hochoetz last as long as possible. From complete beginners to seasoned experts, the extensive and varied network of slopes – all equipped with state-of-the-art lifts – offers something for everyone. While experienced skiers enjoy the more challenging runs, their little ones are well looked after at three ski schools. Several moving carpet conveyors, WIDIs Funpark, various childcare providers and children’s theatre plays leave no room for boredom. The WIDIVERSUM is a brilliant place to play even in winter. New winter hiking paths and signposted snowshoe trails are added regularly. A dedicated uphill line from Ochsengarten to Hochoetz makes the route perfect for ski touring.

Children born in 2017 and younger (ID required) travel free when accompanied by a paying parent in the same ticket category and receive a KidsKühCard (€ 2.00 deposit).

Children's ski course offers from the age of 4 at all ski schools (please book in advance).

- Friday, 29.11.24, to Monday, 21.4.25, daily from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm (cable cars), 9:00 am to 4:15 pm (lifts).

### TICKET AND BOX OFFICE INFORMATION

- **Our staffed ticket offices** are located at the DreiSeenBahn, StartBahn, HochAlterBahn and GaiskogelBahn. For concessions (seniors / youth / child / invalide) please show us your ID without being asked, subsequent complaints cannot be dealt with. We will be happy to advise you!
- Additional **ticket and return machines** can be found at the GaiskogelBahn, HochAlterBahn and DreiSeenBahn.
- You can obtain **online tickets** at [www.kuehtai.info/online-ticket-en](http://www.kuehtai.info/online-ticket-en)
- All **KühCards** are issued on contactless cards, a **deposit of € 2.00** must be paid. If it is returned undamaged to the **return machines, at the ticket offices, in the Kühtai Tourism Information Office**, in restaurants, hotels or shops in Kühtai or at the ticket offices in Oetz/Ochsengarten, you will receive it back.
- Ski passes bought will not be exchanged, changed or taken back and are not transferable.
- Multi-day passes are only valid on consecutive days.
- **StartBahn ticket office:** contact point for groups, refunds after accidents and for the purchase of annual and network tickets.
- **Advance ticket sales:** Please use the advance ticket sales (ticket machines, night skiing or at the hotel) to avoid waiting times the following day. Pay attention to the date at the ticket machines!

### GET INFORMED BEFORE YOU BUY!

- Cards will be withdrawn and not replaced in the event of misuse.
- Piste users ski at their own risk and peril.
- In the event of a skiing accident from the return of a multi-day ticket (at the StartBahn ticket office) with a medical certificate, cash reimbursement of the remaining, unused days of this ticket.
- The right is reserved to close individual lifts during or at the end of the season due to snow conditions and to stop the ski bus service at the end of the season.
- Piste rescue: The rescue takes place up to the medical centre in Kühtai. A fee of € 150.00 will be charged for the piste rescue!

- **Payment for ski tickets:** in cash (Euro), bank card (MAESTRO) and credit cards (MasterCard, Visa, V Pay, UnionPay).



- No refund will be made in the event of poor weather, departure, illness or injury, in case of shutdown of individual facilities, road closure, loss of ski pass, natural disasters, or due to official orders etc.
- Please note that ski touring is not permitted on any of the ski slopes. The use of the slopes is limited to the downhill skiing.
- The court of jurisdiction for all disputes arising from this contract is in Silz. Only Austrian law is applicable.

### Note on liability in all tariff associations

The individual services to which ticket holders are entitled are rendered by private contractors. The contractor who sells the tickets is only acting as the representative of the other contractors. This company is responsible for the provision of individual services and for the payment of any compensation claims made as a result of any accident or injury.

On conclusion of the contract of transport the general business conditions apply. The right is reserved to changes to tariffs, operating times and bus times and to misprints and errors.
