DREISEEN WALK

The DreiSeenBahn cable car quickly takes you up to 2,410 m. From there, past the **Upper Plenderlessee**, you can reach the **DreiSeen-Hut** at 2,311 m on foot in just 8 minutes, with a sun terrace and the new KühPlayground, located right by the Lower Plenderlessee.

You then go back down via the **middle of the Plenderlessee**, on to the Hirschebensee (2,164 m), and back past the High Altitude Training Centre Kühtai to the valey station.

Ascent 40 m / descent 470 m / 5.6 km / 2 h



HÖHENPANORAMAWEG TRAIL TO THE FINSTERTAL RESERVOIR

Go up with the DreiSeenBahn, alight by the Upper Plenderlessee, and you'll reach the DreiSeen-Hut at 2,311 m, which has a terrace and the KühPlayground, and is located right by the Lower Plenderlessee, in just 8 minutes. Then head along the Höhenpanoramaweg trail to the **Finstertal reservoir**. Tip: Visit the Energy Showroom of Tiroler Wasserkraft AG. Return to the Drei-SeenBahn valey station either via the marked and signposted trail or via the asphalted path to Kühtai

Ascent 60 m / descent 490 m / 4.4 km / 1 h 40 min

KÜHTAI VILLAGE WALK

Start at the HochAlterBahn valey station, which has free parking, or right next to the **Gasthof Sonne & Schnee**, located at 2,020 m and with a terrace, go up to the StartBahn mountain station, alighting at Dorfstadl, located at 2,000 m and with a sun terrace, head behind the **Dorfstadl** and go down to the street, walk on the pavement to the Jagdschloss, to the chapel. From there, go to the KaiserBahn valey station, further on to the **Dortmunder Hut** at 1.949 m. which also has a terrace, cross over the road, on the way to the **High Altitude Training** Centre Kühtai, then go up slightly towards Kühtai and go behind the church again in the direction of Gasthof Sonne & Schnee or the HochAlterBahn car park. HIKE AND PLAY

With the DreiSeenBahn at 2,410 m, you can easily walk to the DreiSeen-Hut, the playground is right in front of the terrace. With a great view of Kühtai. The children can conquer the Kühtai letters in the KühPlayground. In addition, a wooden ball track playfully shows elements of alpine farming, such as hay rakes, ribbon fences, hay racks, butter churns, troughs, etc.



ALPENROSE BLOSSOM

Kühtai is located in the middle of a botanical garden at an altitude of 2.020 meters. This alpine floral species, which covers the mountain slopes with its red splendour, blooms from mid-June to mid-July. Numerous hiking trails lead right past the colourful Alpine flowers, that not only delight the eye – the scent of alpine roses is in the already spicy mountain air! Along the slopes, dotted with pink and rusty red flowers, you can choose from comfortable short walks and longer 1-to-3-hour hikes.

Kühtai - Ochsengarten - Hochoetz

The Miner's Trail takes hikers into a landscape that could not be more primal. Swiss stone pine forests between steeply rising mountains alternate with rare, high alpine plants. In summer, sheep inhabit the lonely area. It was not always like this. 350 years ago mine workers faced harsh conditions in this high altitude. At 2,500 m above sea level, Up to 450 miners were searching for copper, galenite and pyrite in this remote area. Discover more about this unique landscape, the mysterious Puchersee and the people who have tried to cultivate this region since centuries.

RESERVOIRS IN KÜHTAI

Top excursion destinations - the Kühtai reservoirs

Visiting the reservoirs in Kühtai is a special experience.

It is fascinating to explore the huge dams and these large lakes with their turquoise shimmering waters. This is why the reservoirs have become really popular destinations. The Sellrain-Silz hydropower plant produces 100% clean electricity, covering about 13% of the total Tyrolean electricity demand.

Finstertal reservoir

This highest reservoir in Kühtai is at 2,325 m, the rockfill dam is 149 m high and 650 m wide, and has a capacity of 60 million m³ of water. You can reach this dam either by using the DreiSeenBahn and further on the high-altitude panorama trail, with a stop at the DreiSeen-Hut, or you can climb straight up

Längental reservoir

The reservoir, with its 45 m high dam, is located at 1,901 m. The starting point for the family-friendly circular hiking trail around the reservoir is the car park right by the reservoir. Due to a few steps at the power plant, the path is unfortunately not suitable for people with disabilities.

Kühtai reservoir (under construction)

The dam, which is located at 2,140 m, is scheduled to start operation in 2027, has a 113 m high and 510 m wide dam wall and a capacity of 31 million m³. It is located in the Längental valley, above the existing Längental reservoir.

ENERGY SHOWROOM

In the showroom at the Finstertal reservoir, visitors can learn more about the dam's construction and technology, the pump storage system and the Sellrain-Silz power plant group. Gain an interesting insight into the power generation from hydropower, open from the beginning of July to end of September, daily from 09:00 am to 5:00 pm

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

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KÜHTAI'S HIGH ALPINE ROAD

The most beautiful route into the mountains in the summer – alpine & urban

On the way to Kühtai you will experience unique landscapes that change constantly with the altitude. The pass summit at 2.020 meters opens up the view of an overwhelming mountain world. On top of all this, it is toll and vignette-free! When driving on the 50 km long High Alpine Road – whether in comfort by car or motorcycle, or in a sporty fashion by bike or mountain bike – Kühtai is always worth a stop along the route or in Kühtai itself. The reservoirs are also easily accessible. You can get from Innsbruck to Kühtai via Kematen in just 30 minutes, and into the Sellraintal valley through the mountaineering villages of Sellrain, Gries and St. Sigmund. Or you can get from Oetz into the Ötztal valley through the wild and romantic Nedertal valley. A variant with many views goes from Haiming to Ochsengarten via Haimingerberg, from there, you can get on the mountain pass to Kühtai.
